Volunteer Role Description - Kitty Match-Maker

Our Kitty-Home Match-Makers identify and allocate foster kitties to forever homes.

CDPA is a registered charity dedicated to caring and improving the lives of cats and dogs in Ireland. Our volunteers collaborate with local communities to reduce animal suffering through our Trap-Neuter-Return, foster-rehoming and welfare programmes.

Role Description

- Understand & Advocate for Each Kitty: Maintain an in-depth understanding of the cats in CDPA's care, including their personalities, likes, dislikes, and forever home requirements.
- **Manage the Adoption Process:** Review applications, reach out to prospective adopters, and conduct virtual home checks to assess suitability based on each cat's needs.
- **Match Cats with Suitable Homes:** Chat with adopters, understand their lifestyle, and help find the perfect match by considering the cat's temperament and requirements.
- **Provide Guidance & Support:** Offer advice on cat enrichment, care, and creating a loving, stress-free environment. Answer adopters' questions to ensure a smooth transition.
- **Maintain Accurate Records:** Update and manage electronic kitty records throughout the adoption life cycle.
- **Collaborate with the Foster Team:** Work closely to ensure a smooth handover when cats move to their forever homes.
- **Offer Post-Adoption Support:** Follow up with adopters to ensure their new feline friend is settling in well and provide ongoing assistance if needed.
